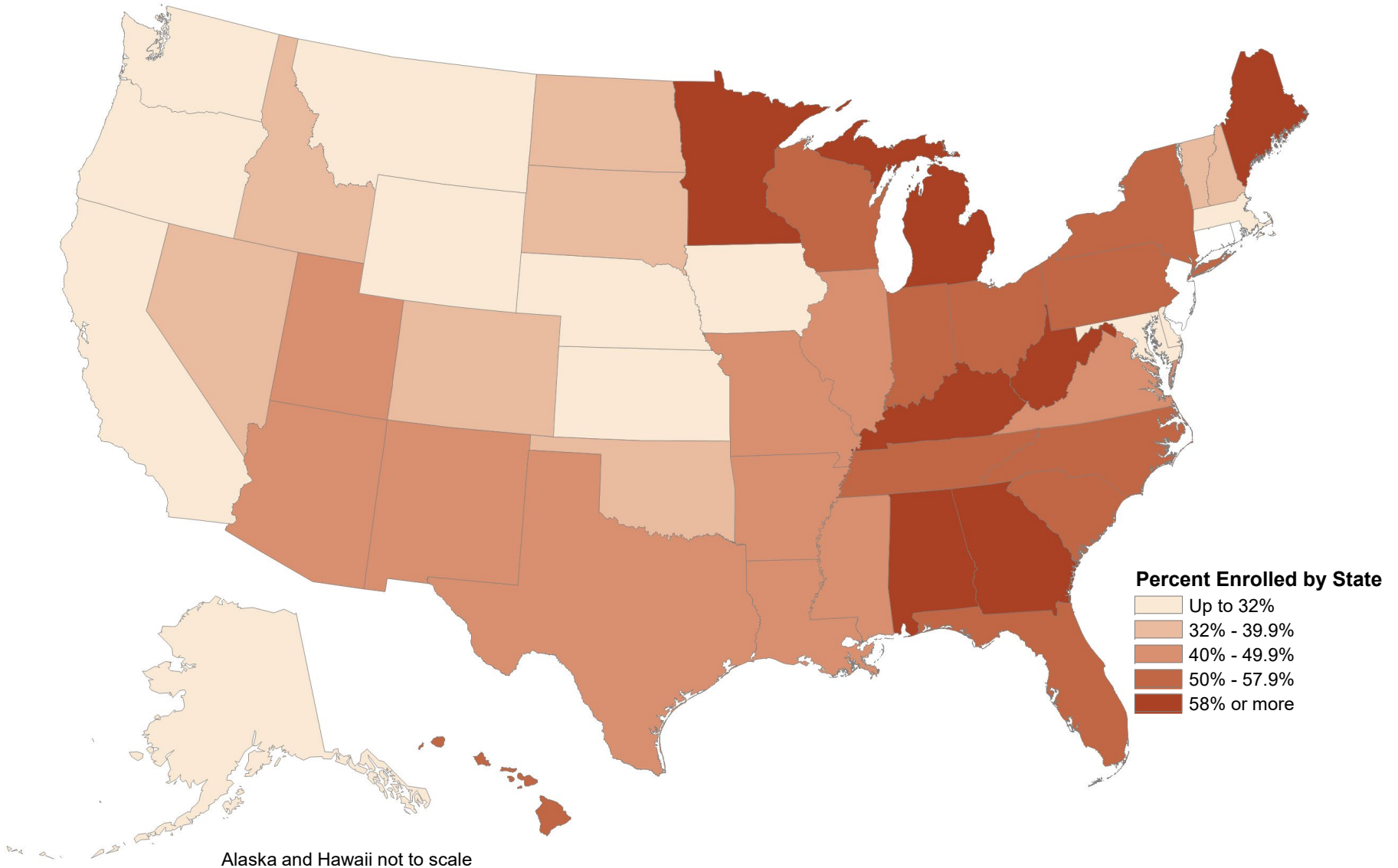


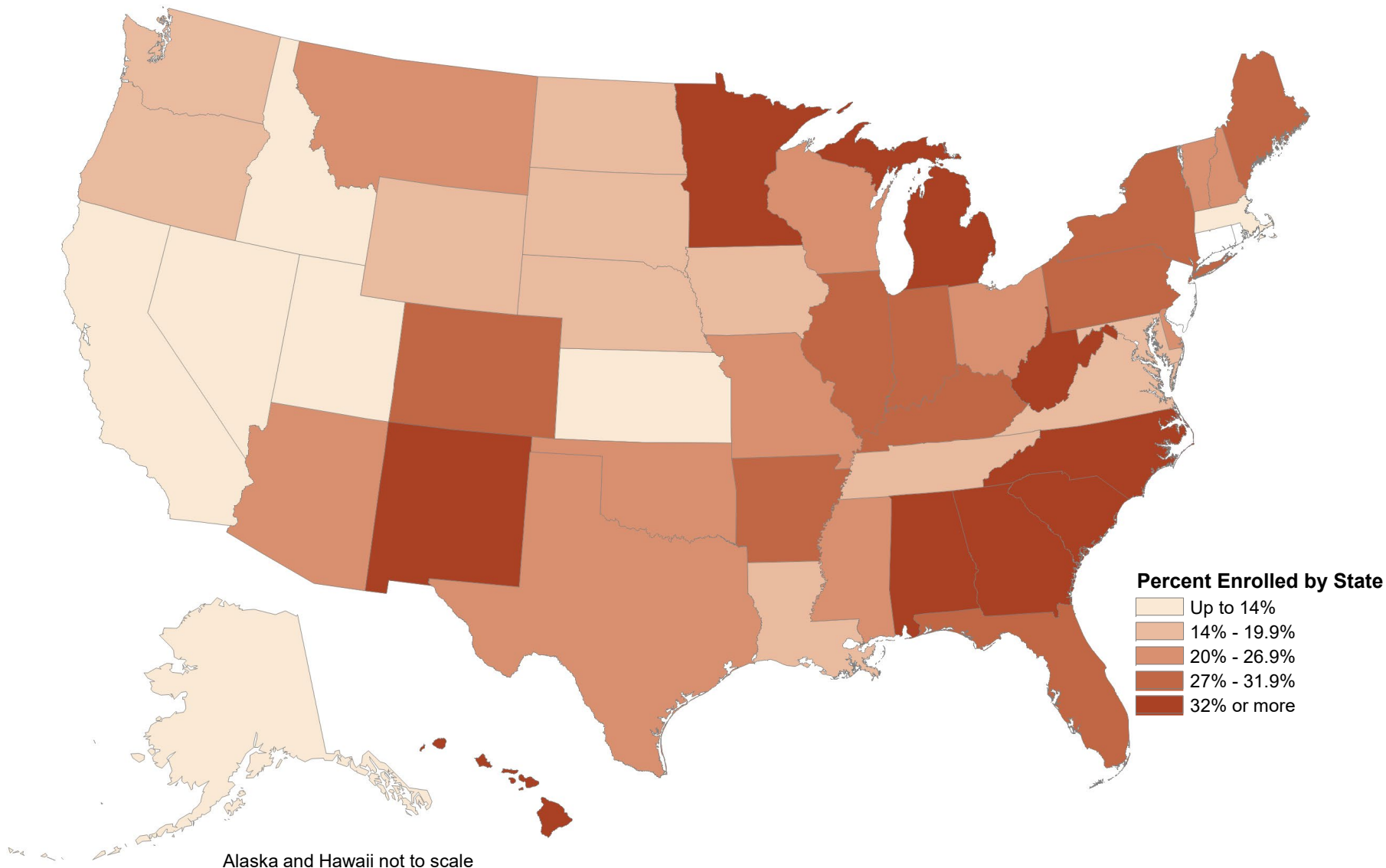
# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024



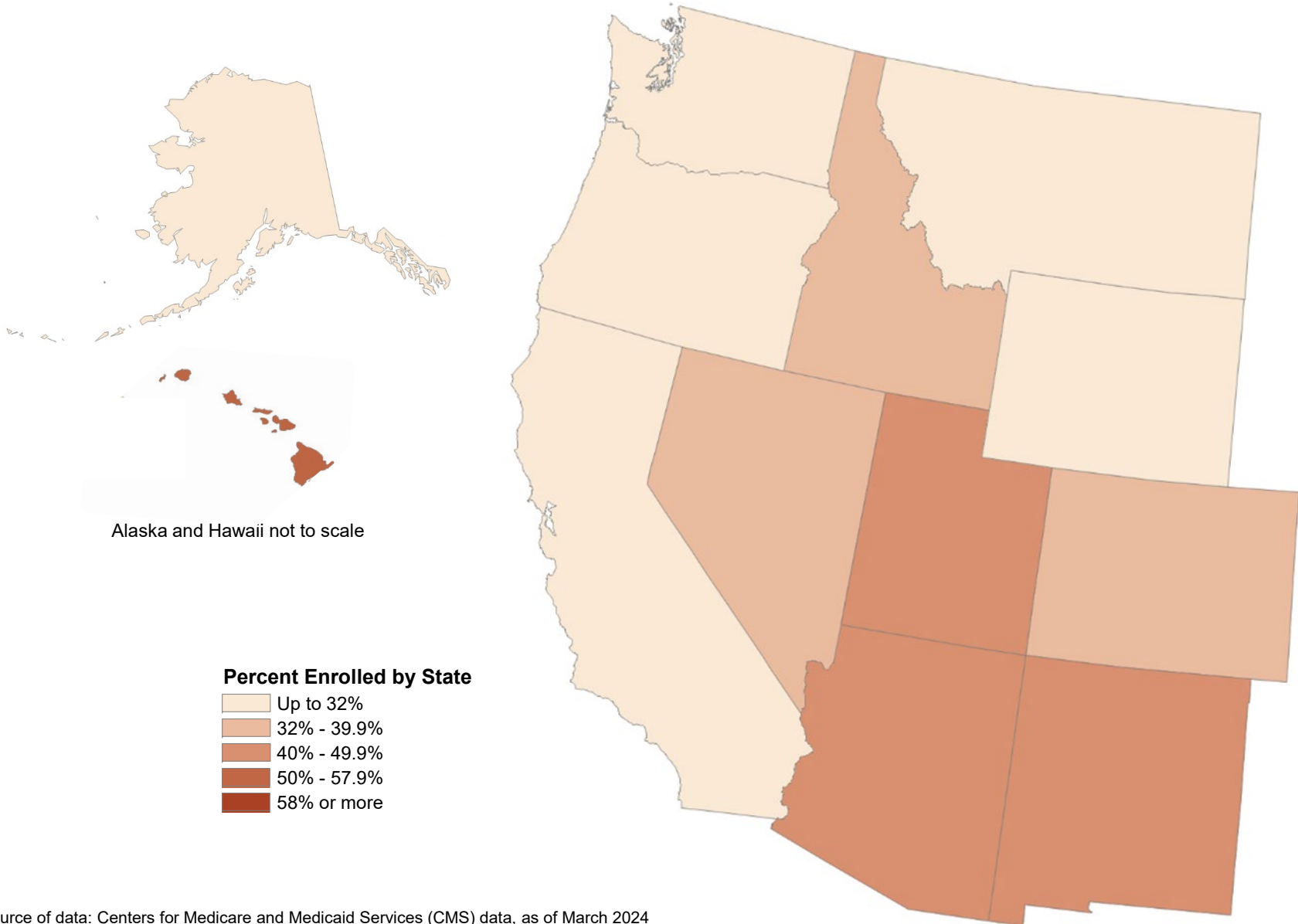

# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024

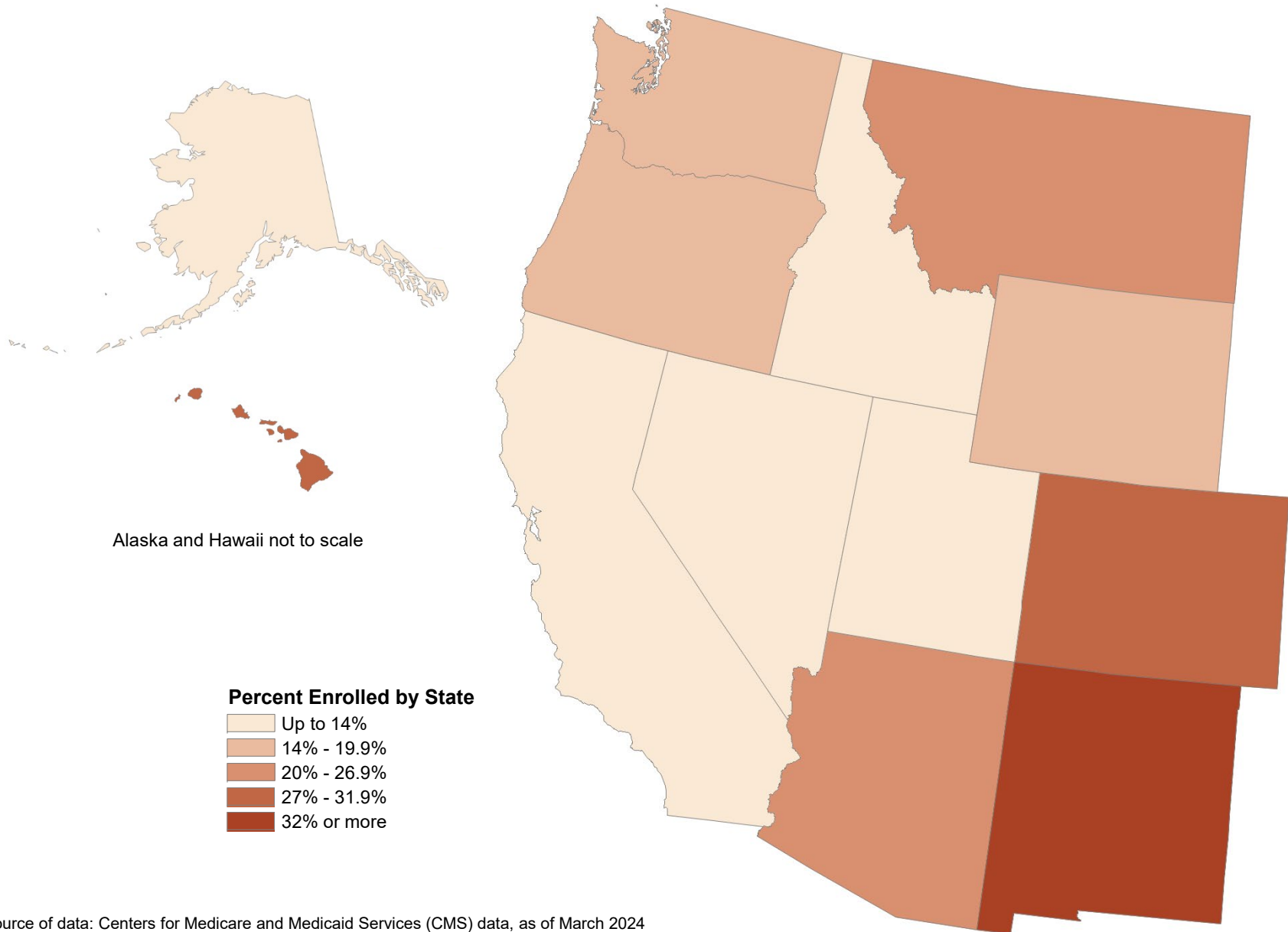

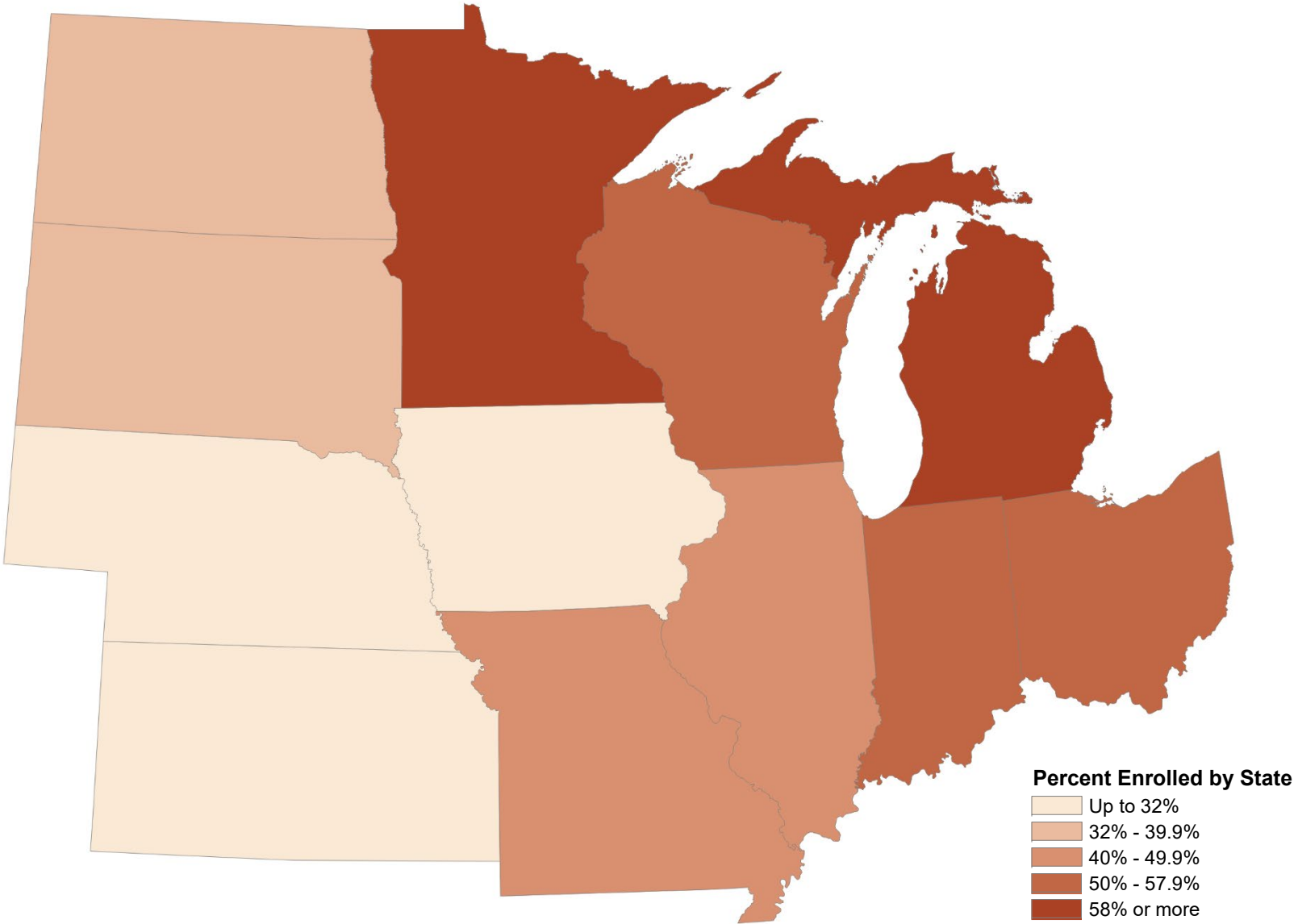

# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Preferred Provider Organizations by State, March 2024

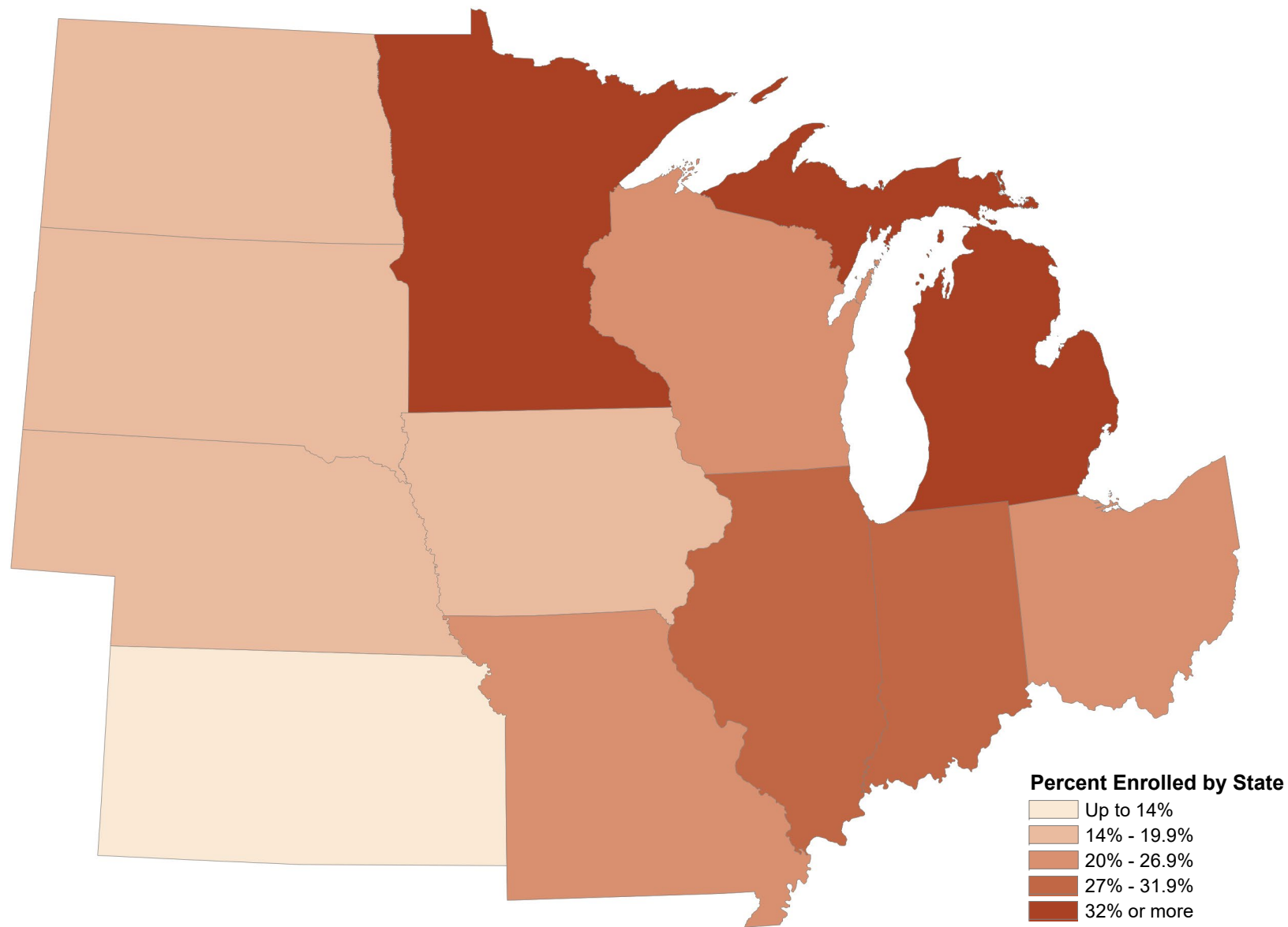


# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024

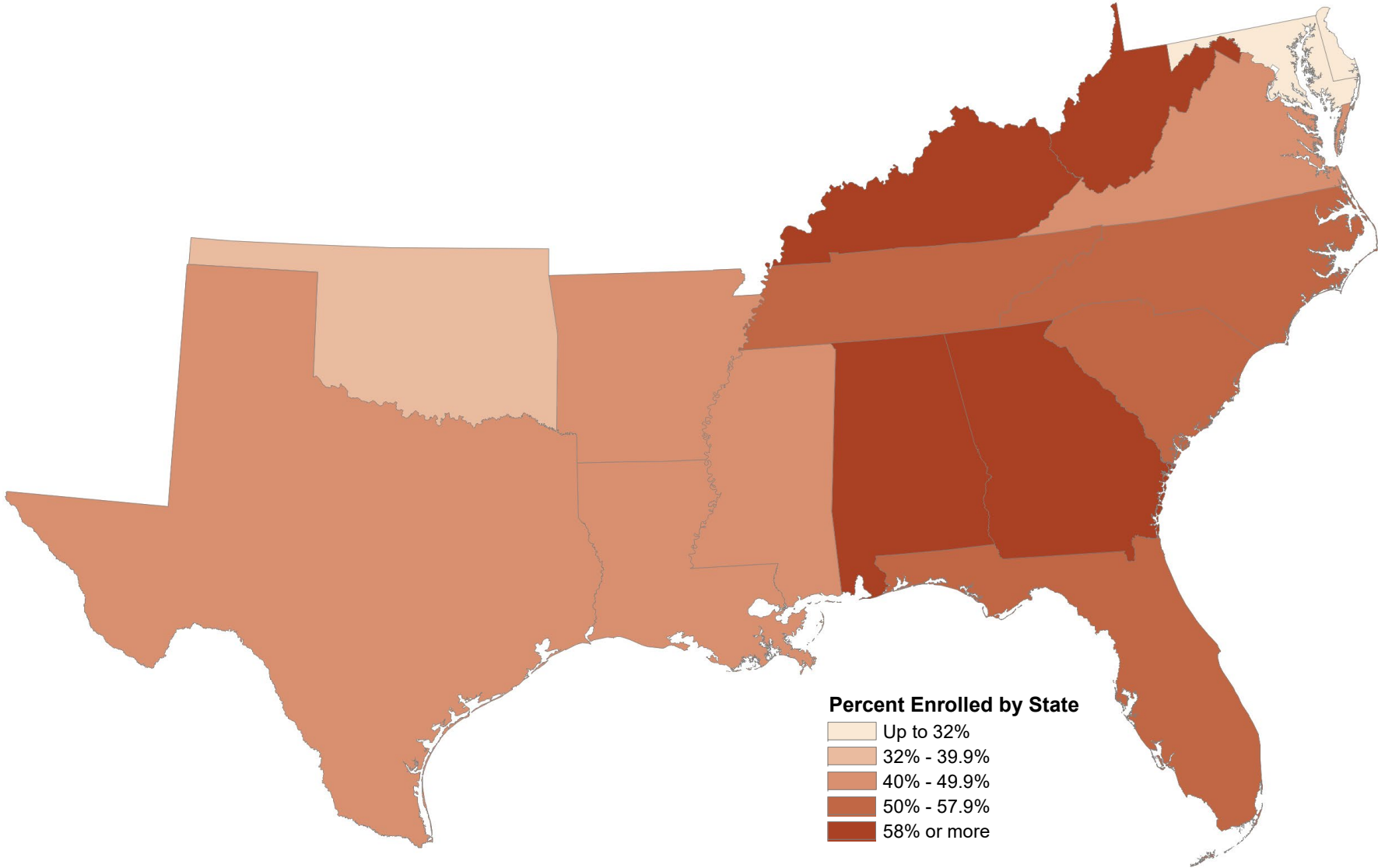
# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Preferred Provider Organizations by State, March 2024

# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024

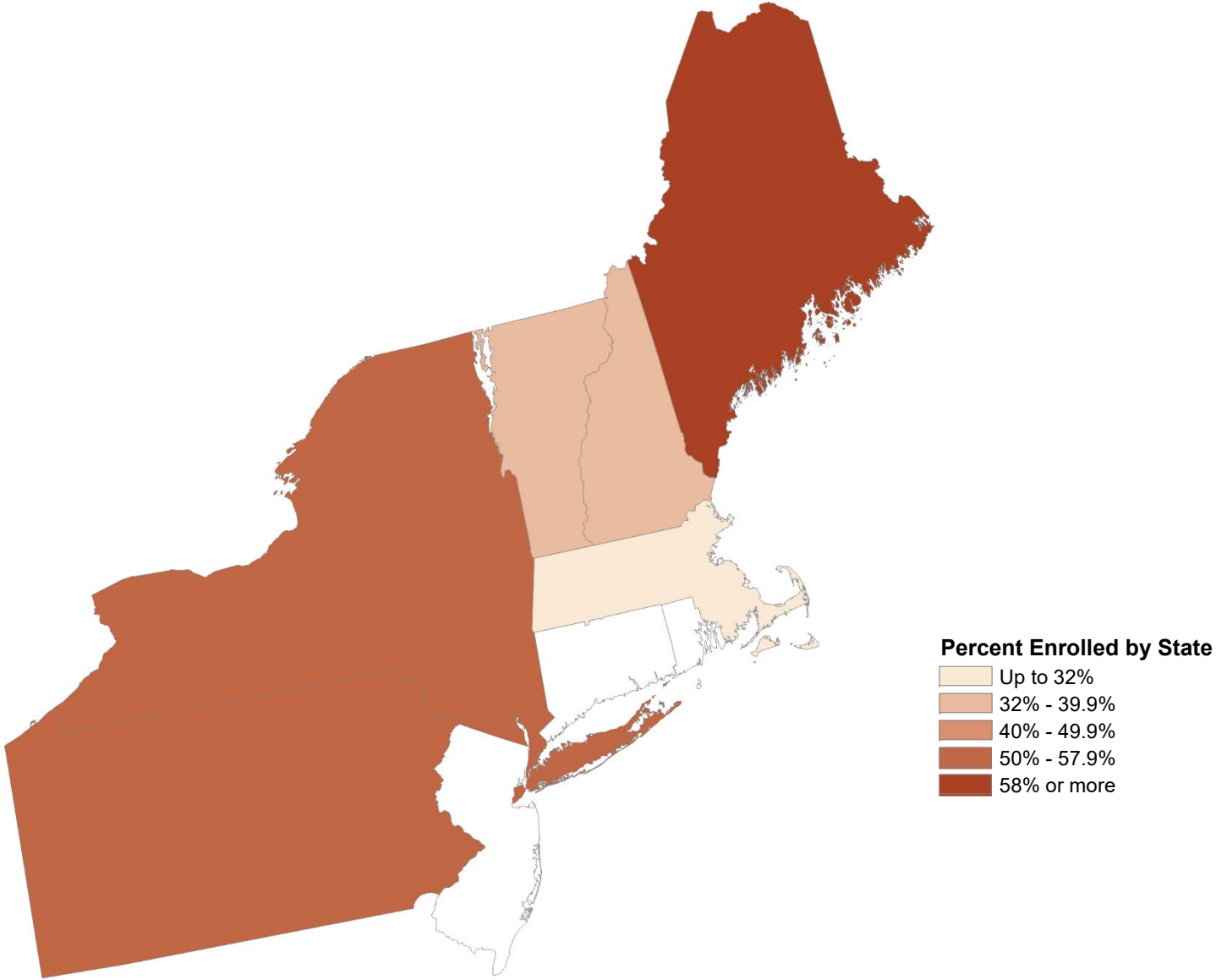

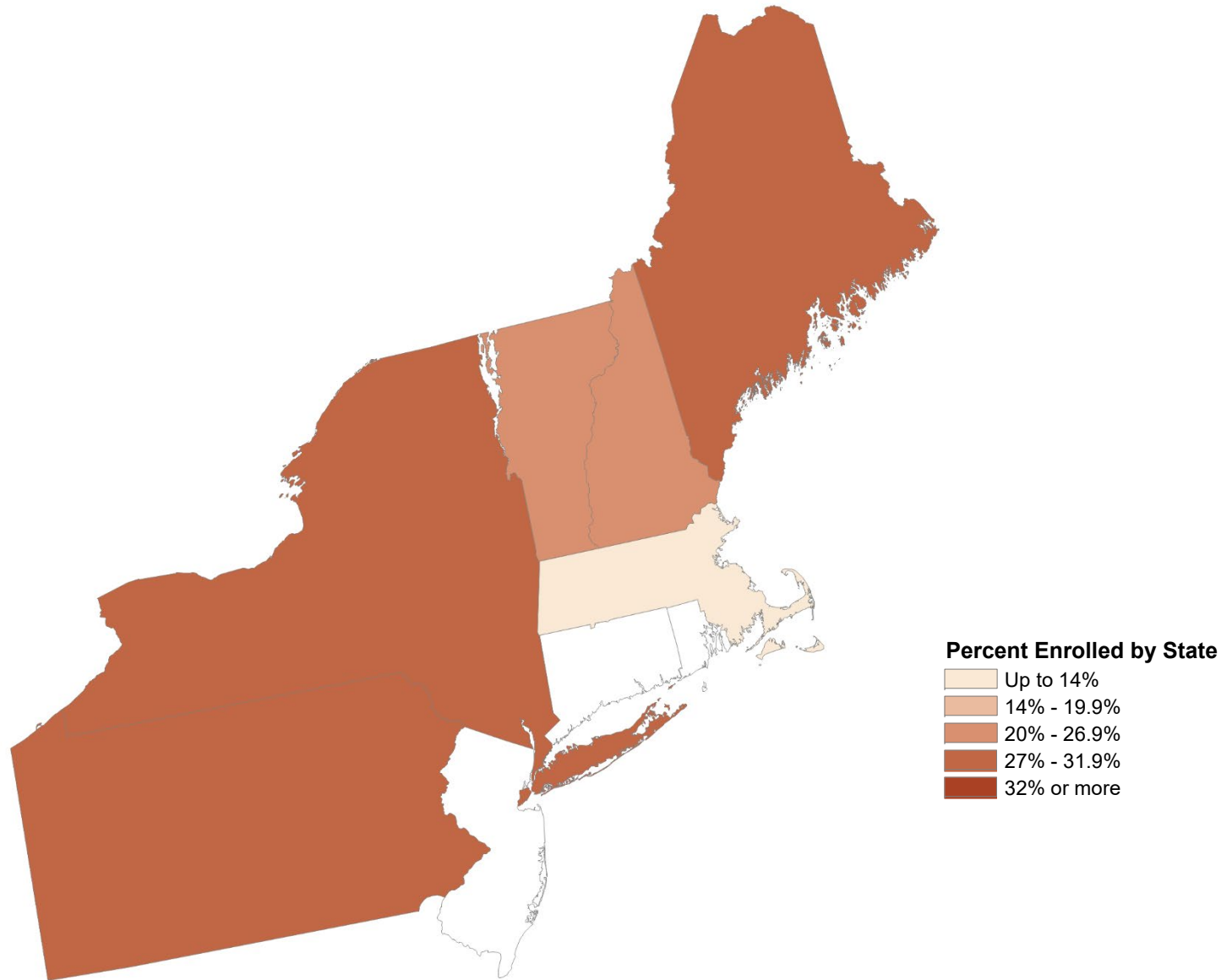
# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024



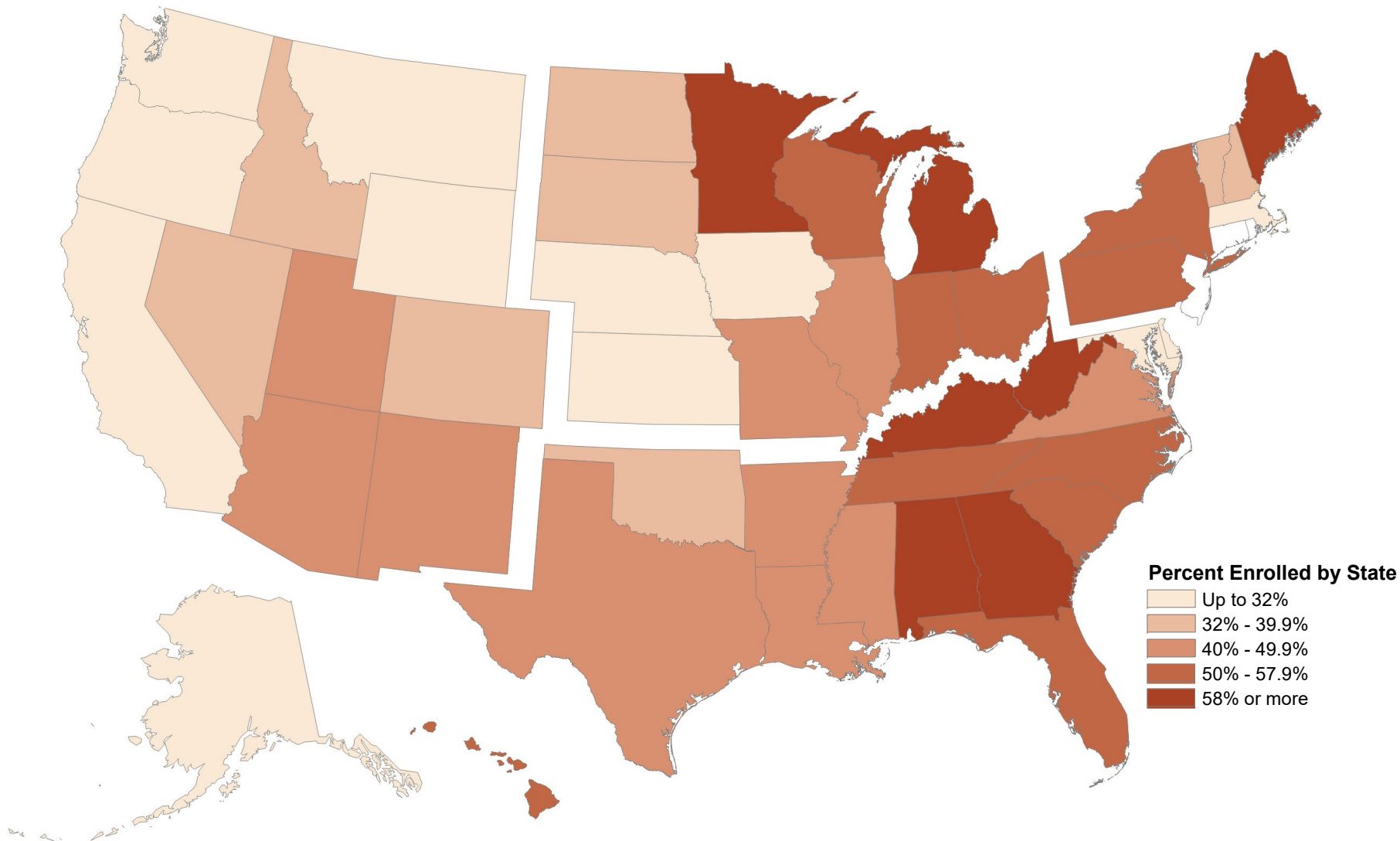

# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Preferred Provider Organizations by State, March 2024

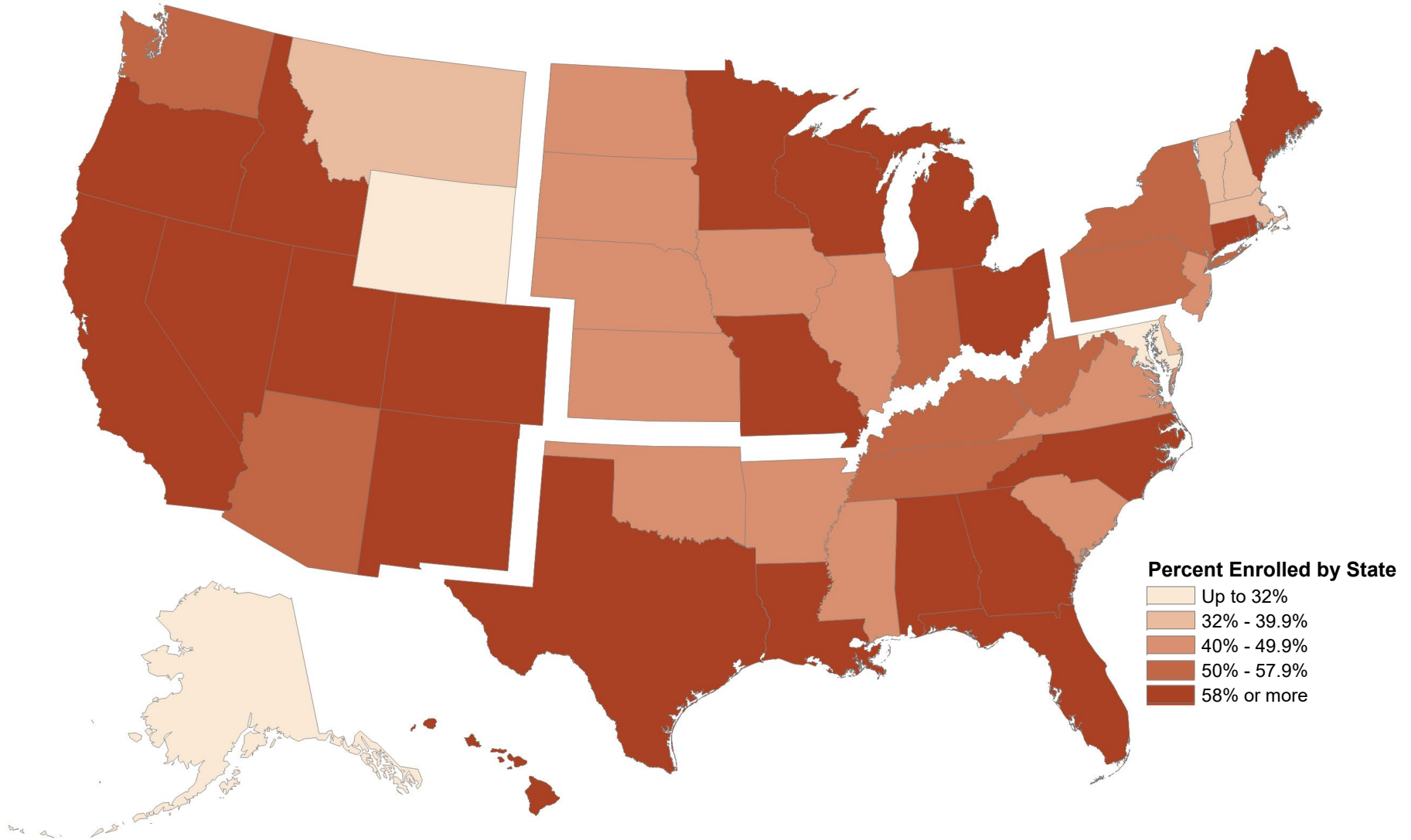


# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage by State, March 2024
