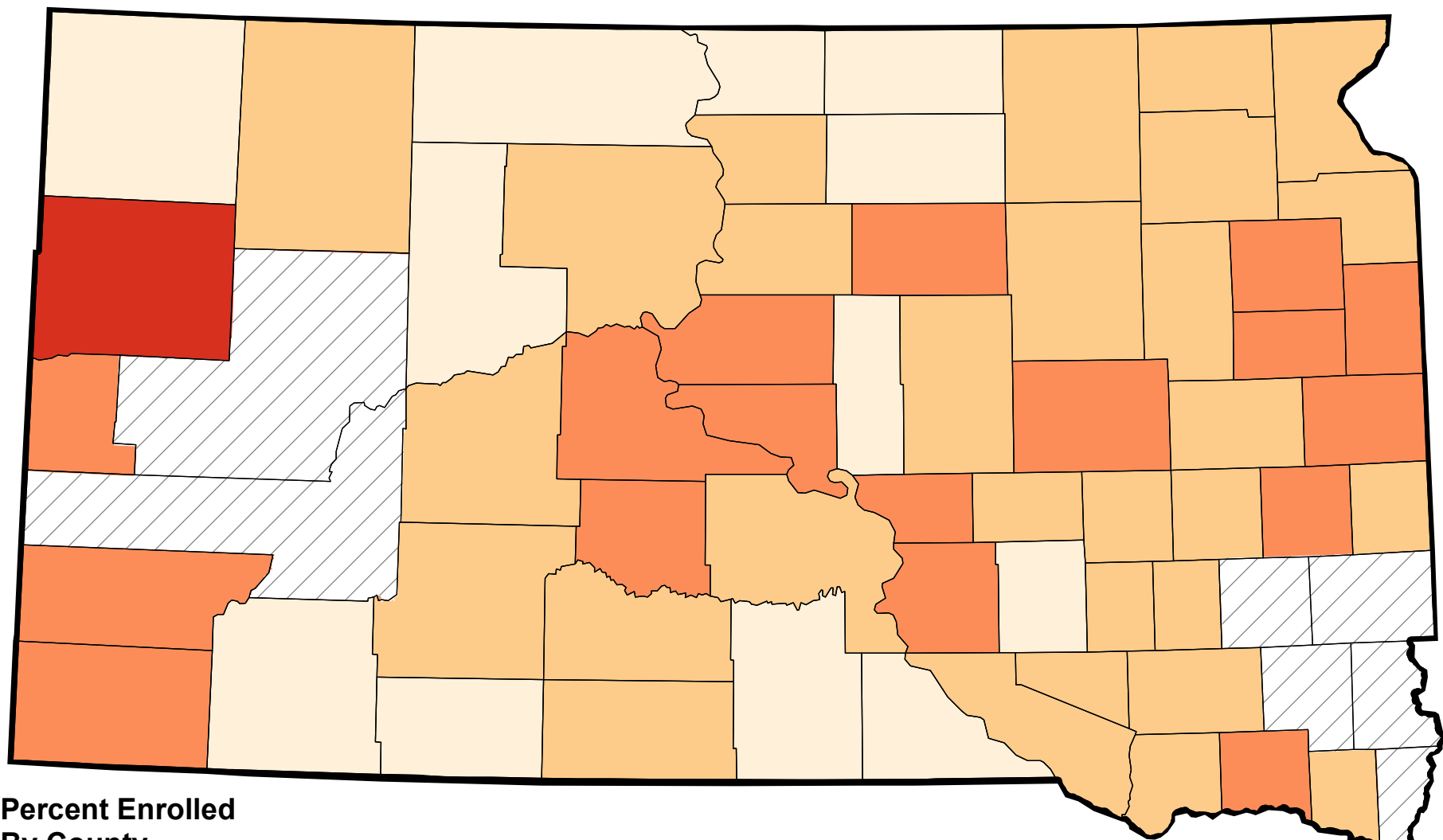








# Percent of Eligible Nonmetropolitan Medicare Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage in South Dakota, June 2009

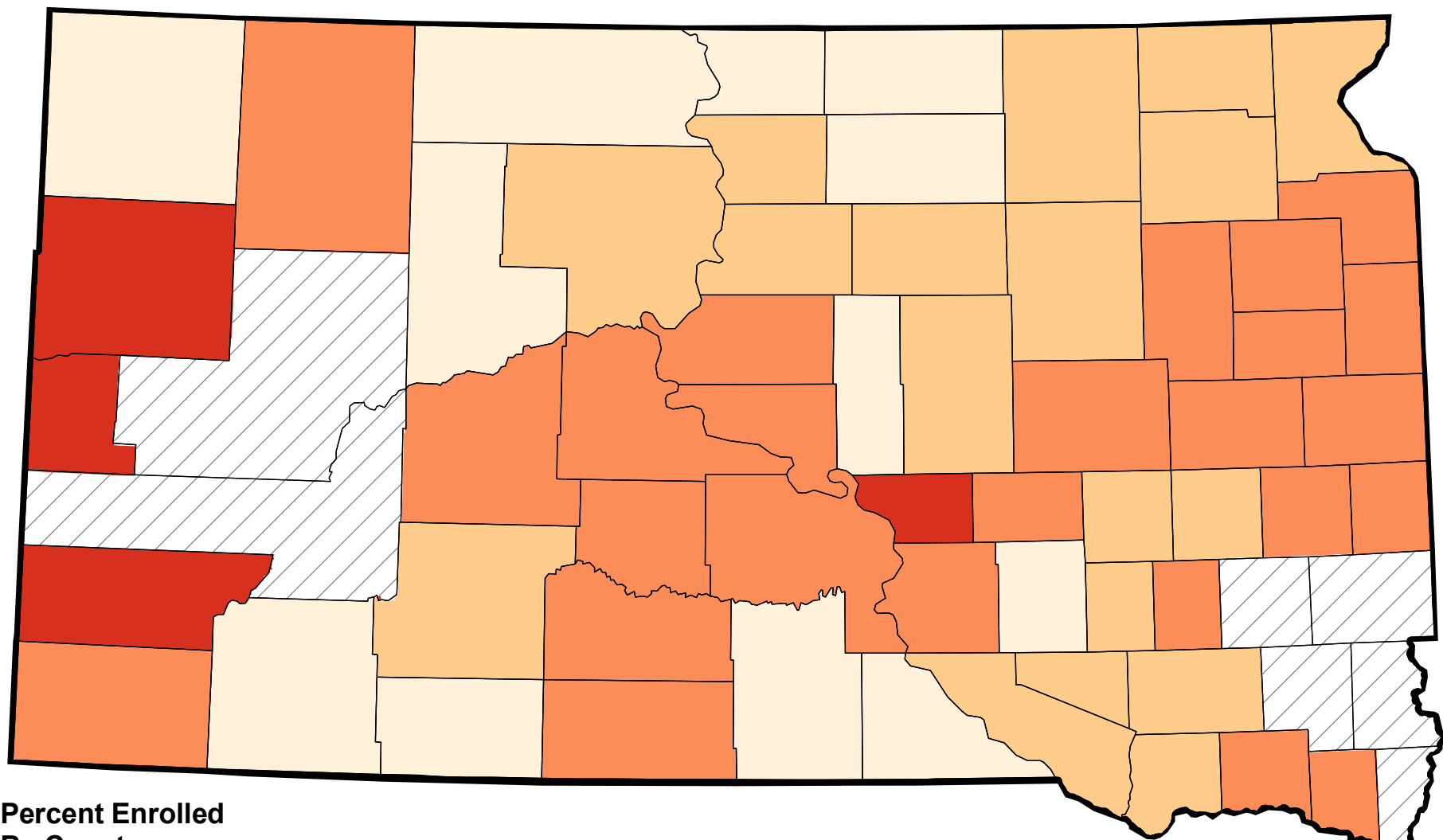


