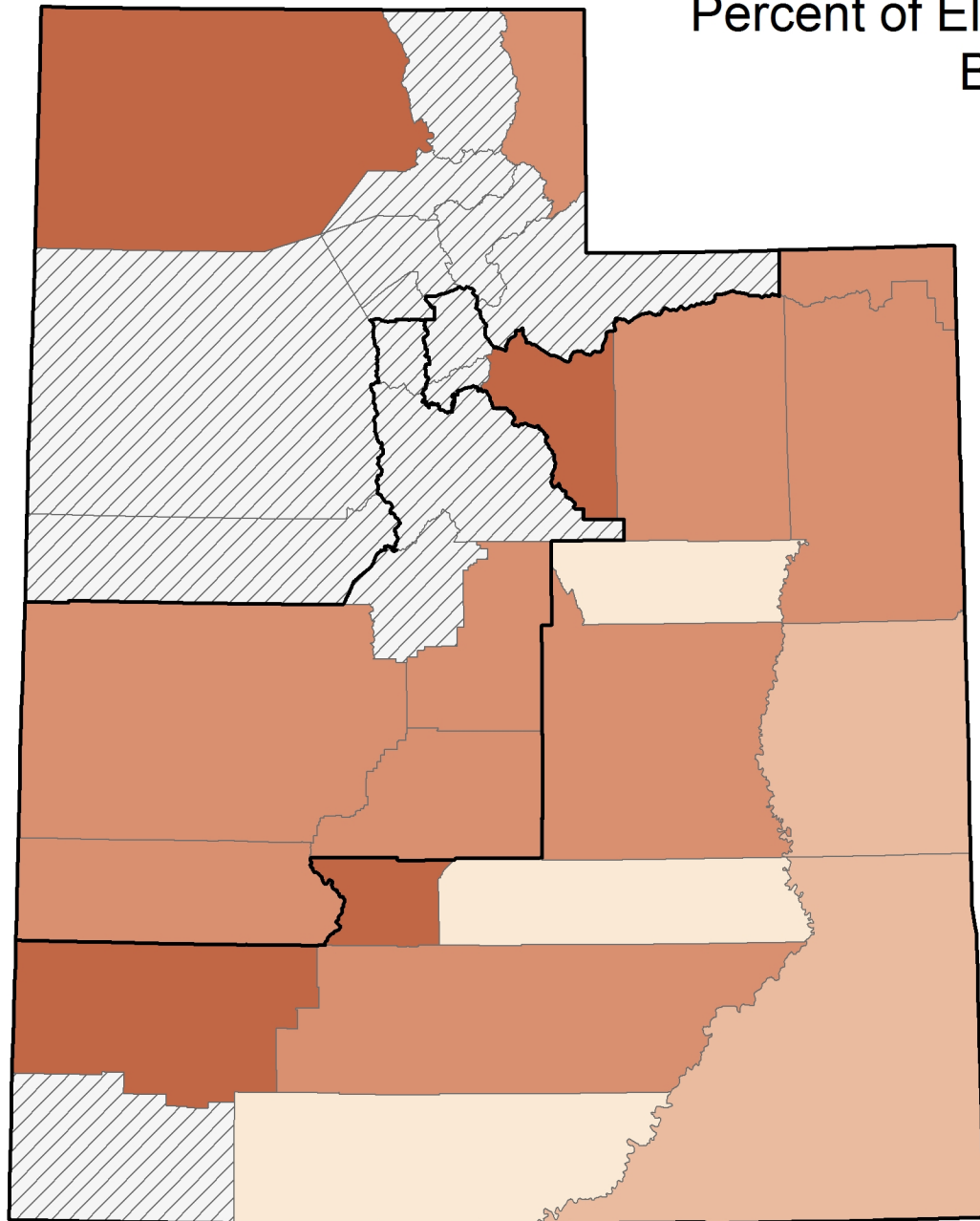









Percent of Eligible Medicare Non-Metropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage in Utah, March 2012

-  Metropolitan Counties

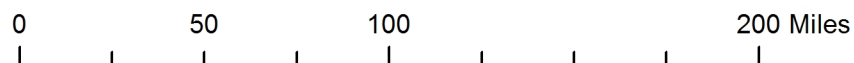

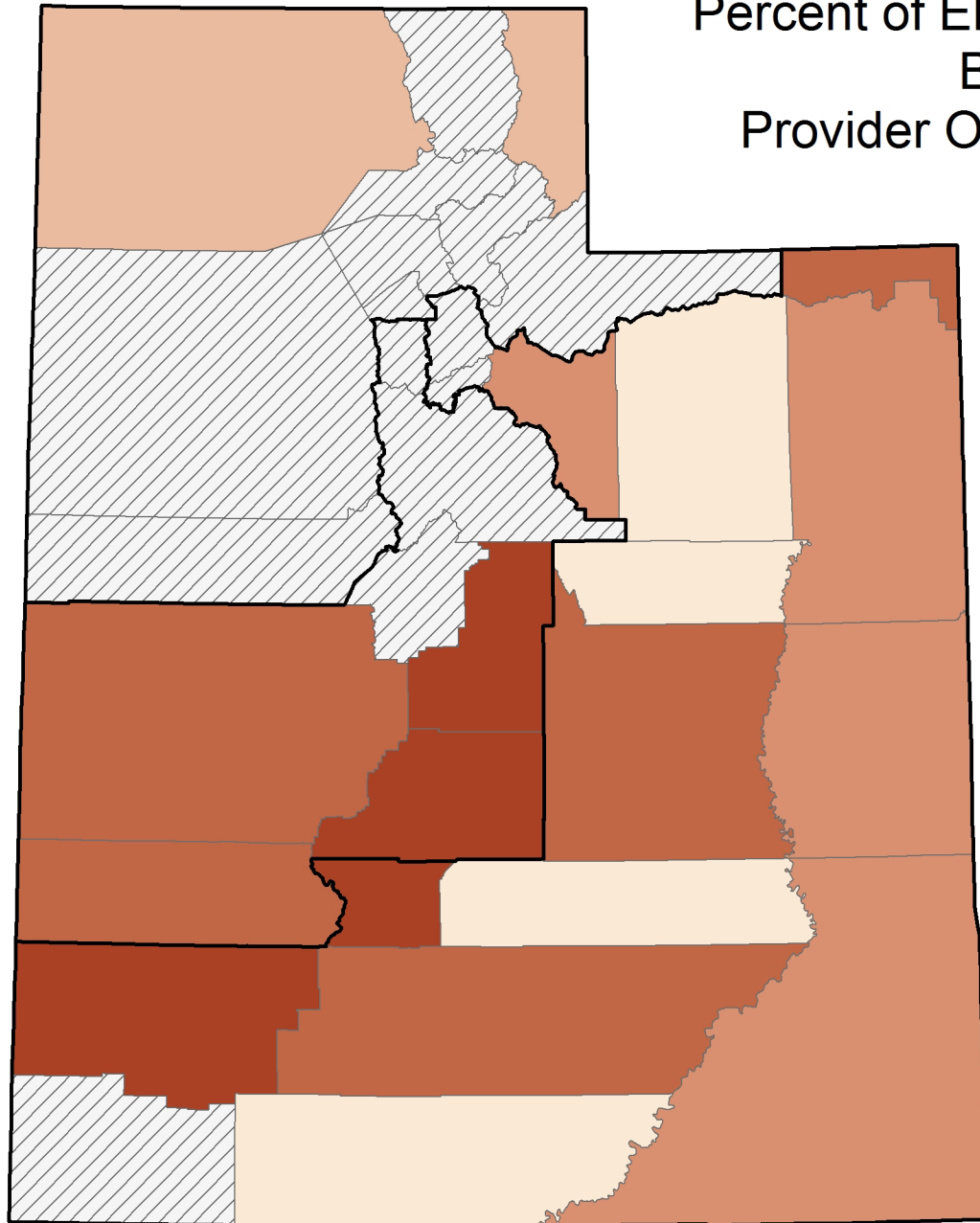
